Public Synopsis of Disciplinary Action Report

In November of 2024, Ptl. Michael Grace was accused of pointing his department-issued Conducted Energy Device (CED) at other Maple Shade Township employees. The Burlington County Prosecutor's Office conducted an independent review of the incident and determined there was not sufficient cause to pursue criminal charges.

During the Maple Shade Police Internal Affairs investigation of the incident, Ptl. Michael Grace resigned from his position with the department. The investigation was completed despite the resignation, which resulted in a sustained finding for departmental rule violations. This incident occurred in 2024, but the investigation was not completed until 2025.

In June of 2024, Ptl. Anthony King was involved in an off-duty single vehicle motor vehicle crash in Deptford Township. As a result of the crash investigation, he was arrested for driving while intoxicated (DWI). The DWI charge was later amended to a reckless driving offense in court. Ptl. King was suspended for 30 days as a result of the incident. This incident occurred in 2024, but the investigation was not completed until 2025.
